This home learning grid will last for 3 weeks and needs to be completed by Friday 18 December 2020.

The home learning grid has some compulsory elements (marked with a star) and a selection of other optional activities for children to choose. Each week in class children will have an opportunity to share which activities they have been doing. Home learning jotters are provided which can be used for written tasks, photos, a log of your activities..... it's up to you!

Please note: Your child will have 8/10 spelling words each week, which will be written in the back of their home learning jotter.

We will be learning to the links between addition and subtraction and how to use a blank number line to help us.</p> <p>At home... - Please do NOT teach your child to add/subtract using carrying. Thanks. - Practise speed when + and – using Daily 10 Level 2/3 is about right. - Remember to keep using Sumdog too. -Do an activity from the KIRF sheet. P3/4 are the first 2 green and blue boxes.</p>	<p>Literacy </p> <p>In School... We will be writing reports about the Romans and working on our research skills.</p> <p>At home... -Practise your spelling words by trying one or more of the spelling activities on TEAMS -Reading: Check your reading record to see which pages to read. - Do more research at home on a Roman topic that interests you. Take helpful notes.</p>	<p>Health & Wellbeing </p> <p>In school... We are learning about things that make us similar and different. Our resilience focus is “Keep Connected”.</p> <p>At home... - Try some of the “Keep Connected” activities from the resilience home learning sheet available on TEAMS - Write/ draw about how you are similar/ different to friends/ family members/ neighbours.</p>	<p>News & Other reminders</p> <p>In school...
