Numeracy & Maths



In school...

We will continue our work on measurement. We will be learning how to make simple conversions such as 1m 58cm = 158cm, estimating measurements and checking our answers, be able to use a range of instruments to measure (eg metre stick, digital scales, measuring jugs etc. Our number work will include times tables, problem solving and division.

At home...

- Revise Tables
- Practical activities to help consolidate understanding of measurement

Literacy



In school...

Reading and spelling will continue as normal. In writing we will be learning how to write simple playscripts.

In our other literacy work we will be learning about dictionary and thesaurus skills.

In Listening & Talking we will be trying out our playscripts and making voice instructions to link in with our coding work

At home...

- Read for 20mins each evening
- Practise the spelling words, play games and use them in writing

Our work on rights continues. This month we will be learning about Article 34/36, 13, 32 and 22. In our RSHP work we will be talking about different ways we can feel safe. Our building resilience focus is Challenge your Mindset. The key messages are:

- *who we are and what we are good at is not fixed*
- *the way we think, feel, learn shapes our brain*
- *I can change through the choices I make*
